

Hi Joyce, "I think the lists are great, and should be used as guidelines ..and they change daily, so we as DJ's need to refer to them, but we also need to maintain the flexibility to play old and classic dances that might not be on the list - if they are ones that we know are favorites of some of the folks in attendance. More than anything, the lists are helpful in reminding the DJ's that we need to split the floor (for couples as well!) and we need to play old and new dances so everyone can dance."
