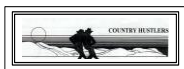

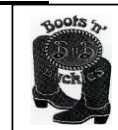

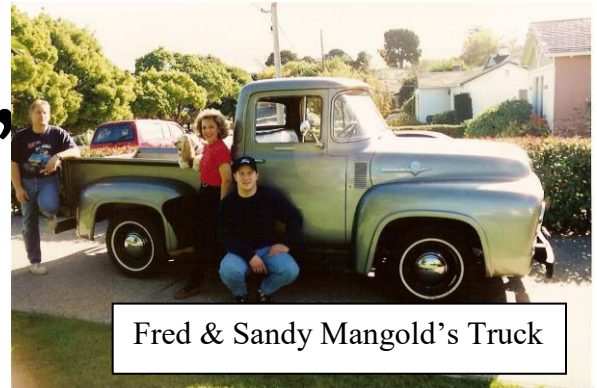

Welcome New Board Member Donna Case, Membership



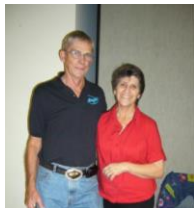

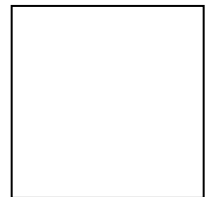
