Dance floor tips!

We've been having great turnouts for our dances lately, but this can create issues related to crowded dance floors. Here are a few reminders of basic dance floor etiquette that can make the dancing more enjoyable for all of us:

- 1. Line dancers are requested to use the center of the dance floor, leaving room for partner dancers to dance around the perimeter of the room.
- 2. Line dancers are also requested to keep in lines, and dance with smaller steps when the floor is crowded.
- 3. If you are a beginner line dancer, you may feel more comfortable dancing in the middle of the line dance formation where you can observe dancers on all sides of you.
- 4. When dancing partner dances, always travel in a counter-clockwise direction and stay around the outer edge of the dance floor.
- 5. When not dancing, please stay off the dance floor area; visit with friends in the kitchen or hallway, or while seated.
- 6. It is mandatory that you have fun and enjoy each others company!
