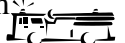

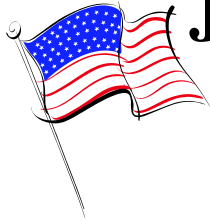

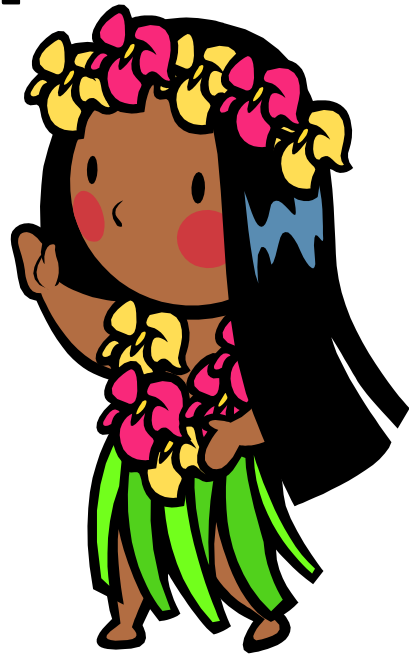

The past twenty years I have been working with children as a school counselor. The last ten years I have been working at Stuart Hall for Boys, a private San Francisco school for boys in grades K-8. The only time I haven't worked was when my kids were little. I have two grown children. Sommer is 29 and Terence is 27.

My main hobby is black and white photography. Dancing relieves my stress physically. Photography nurtures my soul. When I am in the dark room at Skyline College, time disappears. I have received a couple of awards and had two small shows, but it's the process that keeps me at it. I love all of it: the picture taking, developing the film and printing in the dark room. Currently I am experimenting with alternative printing techniques and working on developing a style of my own. I started dancing at the age of four. I took ballet and modern dance for twelve years. As a junior in high school I gave up ballet to be a pompom girl. In college, I was a "go go" girl at Cal, (we danced at rallies). Unfortunately I gave dancing up in my twenties. Then, eight years ago, I was in Half Moon Bay at the Flower Market. A group of Jim Williams' line dancers were doing a demonstration. I remember watching our very own John Gallo and thinking, "I want to do that," and signed up for lessons in Pacifica where I live. I wasn't a fan of country music but have learned to like it. I prefer a nightclub two-step or Latin beat, and I really love rock and honky tonk. My favorite line dance is "Amazing." My favorite country line dances are "Stampede" and "Hot Tamales."

I have done choreography since the age of six. My ballet teacher required us to choreograph a dance every January. If she liked it, we did it in the June recital. In high school I choreographed our school musical, "Our Town." I also choreographed many of our pompom routines.

My favorite of the line dances I have written is "Stay," done to Jackson Browne's version. But I am having lots of fun doing "Gonna Get You."

My favorite dancers/choreographers are John Robinson and Simon Ward.

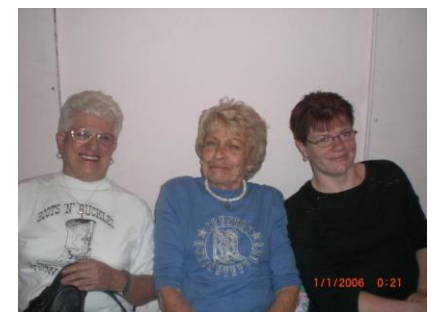
I am so happy I found this wonderful dance community.

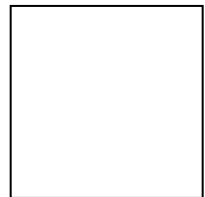
