Unfortunately we were unable to get a hall for May 7, which was supposed to be our Black and White Ball with DJ's Evelyn 'n Denny , but they were very gracious and stepped down so that we could re-schedule it for May 21 with the King, NEIL Hale resplendent in his tuxedo. Sixty-five dancers in black and white attended, and Neil did his usual professional job keeping the floor filled. Our next dance is at Barrett on June 4, with DJ's DIANA and TINA .. Purple Paradise is the theme.

PLEASE READ: The board met at my house on Sunday,

May 15, for a lengthy discussion on the future of the club. Unfortunately it was confirmed that the Club is losing between \$2,500 and \$3, 600 per year, and if we continue to lose money at this rate, the Club will fold in 3—4 years; I'm sure none of us want that to happen. In an effort to slow down our losses, the Board has decided, at this time, to do the following, which was presented at a General Membership meeting the night of the Black and White Ball:

The Birthday Bash will still remain FREE. You will still receive your FREE Birthday dance, we will still have FREE root beer floats on Hot August Nights, and will continue to cater New Year's Eve.

The Straight Shooter will receive a 'face lift', but it will be a bi-monthly issue instead of monthly (July/August, September/October etc.), which will be a saving of approximately \$620 per year.

The Board approved the next decision, but the final decision was up to the members present, to raise the admission from \$8 to \$10 members, and from \$10 to \$12 non-members.... the vote to increase the admission was UNANIMOUS; this will commence as of July 1st.

All Clubs are struggling, attendance is dropping due to the 'maturing process', lack of interest etc.

WE NEED YOUR ATTENDANCE to help the Club stay afloat for years to come. Not only are we dancing for the health of it, it is also gives us the opportunity to socialize with good friends.

I always look forward to seeing you on the dance floor.
