Joyce, The new dance list guidelines make it much easier on me as a DJ because it takes much of the guess work out of the evening's playlist. Also, it is less likely that any one group of dancers will dominate the selection of dances for the evening, as the guidelines specify the rotation of a classic, an oldie, and a newer dance. This sounds like a very equitable format, and at the end of the evening I haven't made any enemies because I didn't play any classics, oldies, or new dances, rather an even mix of all of them.
