
Spring, glorious spring .. the birds are tweeting, the bees are buzzing etc. etc.

Country Quicksteppers "Three Dance Format"

Most of our members are aware the our club is known for our "Three Dance Format". They may even know that this means that every third dance played is supposed to be an "Oldie", a "Favorite" and a "New" dance. But, does everyone really know what these terms mean? As defined by the Quicksteppers Board over recent years, a dance is "New" for one year from the time it is released. If, at the end of that year it is still actively being requested and danced, it is moved to "Favorites" If it has come and gone and is no longer being requested, it is just removed. Dances stay on the "Favorites" list until such time as they are no longer being requested, in which case they are removed, or until the Board decides to move them to the "Oldies" list. The lists are updated about four times a year, and the changes are sent to all of our DJ's o they can update their lists. The "Oldies" and the "Favorites" lists are posted on our web site, countryquicksteppers.org. The "New" lists are maintained and updated by each DJ. An older dance that had "gone away", and then is re-taught, is put on the "Favorites" list, not the "New" list. We hope this explanation will clear up any misunderstanding. We know that as new dancers join our dance family, they may have no idea how old a dance is, so the lists on our web site can be a useful resource.
